

Regulation of V.N.C. Operation for Members – 2025

1. Parking at V.N.C.

- 1.1. The parking area in front of the main entrance of V.N.C. and the "Armonia" parking lot are for the exclusive use of Club Members.
- 1.2. Mopeds, bicycles, and scooters must remain in the designated parking area and are not allowed inside the facilities.
- 1.3. Parking is only allowed for vehicles displaying the special 2025 parking sticker.
- 1.4. The drivers must follow the instructions of the parking attendants.
- 1.5. Entering the parking lot from the exit lane is strictly prohibited. Priority must always be given to vehicles leaving the parking lot.
- 1.6. Circular traffic flow within the parking area must remain unobstructed.
- 1.7. Blocking the entrance to V.N.C. is strictly forbidden to ensure emergency vehicle access (ambulance, police, fire department, etc.).
- 1.8. In special cases, parking may be temporarily restricted.
- 1.9. Compliance with these rules is mandatory for any Member using the V.N.C. parking facilities.
- 1.10. Members who disagree with these terms must park their vehicles outside the Club's premises.

2. Entrance to N.O.B. Facilities

Only Members and their guests are allowed entry through the main entrance.

3. Accompanying Guests

- 3.1. If a member is the sole registrant in their membership category and is entitled to an Accompanying Guest, he/she may use up to 100 guest visits per year. This number cannot be renewed.
- 3.2. Accompanying Guests cannot be first- or second-degree relatives or former (primary or dependent) Members of Vouliagmeni Nautical Club.

4. Visitors of Members

- 4.1. Each family membership is entitled to:
 - 20 visits per year, Monday to Friday, 06:00–20:00, excluding public holidays.
 - 50 visits per year, Monday to Sunday, 20:00–02:00, including public holidays.
- 4.2. The restriction on visits during weekend and holiday is due to high Member attendance, ensuring all Members are accommodated.
- 4.3. The reception staff will assist in managing visitor entry.
- 4.4. Visitors of Members who hold a boat mooring at V.N C. may enter solely for immediate departure by boat. Each boat owner is allowed 100 guest entries per year. Prior email notification to the Secretariat with guest details and estimated departure/return times is required.
- 4.5. Additional visits beyond the allocated quota cannot be granted.

5. Pets

Pets are not allowed on the premises.

6. Delivery Services

- 6.1. The use of third-party food and beverage delivery services is not allowed.
- 6.2. Vouliagmeni Nautical Club operates a restaurant, lounge area, and canteens for Member convenience.
- 6.3. Aligned with the Club's philosophy, supporting it's catering partners is essential as they play a vital role in the Club's well-being.

7. Use of N.O.B. Equipment (Chairs, Sunbeds, Shades)

- 7.1. Sufficient seating and sunbeds are available, with each Member entitled to one seat or sunbed.
- 7.2. Members must place their personal towel on chairs and sunbeds before use for hygiene reasons. Sitting on sunbeds in swimsuits without a towel is prohibited.
- 7.3. Reserving seats with personal belongings is not allowed.
- 7.4. Moving sunbeds under the pergola of the South Beach dining area is prohibited.

8. Cleanliness

- 8.1. Every Member is individually responsible for maintaining the Club's cleanliness.
- 8.2. Waste must be disposed of in designated trash and recycling bins, and used tables should be left clean.
- 8.3. The Club exclusively manages the care of its resident cats, including feeding, medical care, and sterilization. Members are not allowed to intervene or introduce new cats.
- 8.4. V.N.C.'s ensures regular disinfection of common areas (changing rooms, toilets, elevators, turnstiles, etc.).
- 8.5. Cigarette butts must be disposed of in ashtrays.
- 8.6. Writing or graffiti on the premises is prohibited.

9. Safety

- 9.1. Minors are always under the supervision of their parents. This is not only for their safety both in the sea and on land, but also for supervising them within the Club's facilities. The Club hosts its athletes and members, and during our presence, we kindly ask that we respect those around us.
- 9.2. Members are responsible for their personal belongings. V.N.C. is not liable for any loss or damage. Lost items found by the cleaning staff are placed in a designated lost-and-found box near the Secretariat and will be kept for one week before being discarded.
- 9.3. Staff are not responsible for retrieving lost items.
- 9.4. Any damage to Club property should be reported to staff for immediate repair.
- 9.5. The premises are monitored by a video surveillance system for the protection of individuals and property, in accordance with Law 2472/1997.

10. Safe Swimming

- 10.1. Swimming is permitted only within designated safe zones.
- 10.2. Boats, windsurf or sup boards and other water vessels are prohibited in these areas.
- 10.3. Fishing and spearfishing are not allowed.
- 10.4. Lifeguard instructions must be followed.

11. Water and Electricity Conservation

Members are encouraged to use water and electricity in a responsible manner. Always ensure that faucets are fully closed and lights in changing rooms/toilets are turned off when not in use.

12. Use of Showers

The use of shampoo or shower gel in outdoor showers is prohibited.

13. Cleaning of SUP Boards

Cleaning SUP boards with any detergent or soap is prohibited. Members are strongly advised to ensure that when their children wash their boards, there is no excessive use of water and no disturbance is caused to those around them.

14. Noise Pollution

The use of personal audio devices or musical instruments is not allowed. Only background music approved by the Club is permitted, and it must be played at a low volume.

15. First Aid & Medical Assistance

In case of emergency, Members should contact the V.N.C. nurse at the on-site medical office. Lifeguards stationed at the Ski area and South Beach towers are also equipped with first aid supplies.

These regulations are in place to ensure a pleasant and safe experience for all Members.

Compliance is mandatory.
